CHANGING THE WORLD

Cannabis sativa (*hemp plant*).—A well known ancient native of India and Persia, and largely cultivated in its native lands. In our country it is said to be high, but in Italy sometimes 20 ft. high. In places growing singly, the stem is much branched, but in masses it is generally simple. It is said where the arid, sub-tropical plants cannot be easily grown, well grown plants looking greenish and distinct, and are useful at the backs of borders and in mixed groups, and a few look well as a separate group. It should be sown in the open ground early in April, and to get a good plant it would be best to raise it in flats. It loves a warm sandy loam, and is one of the few plants that thrive in small garden patches. There are several varieties, mentioned in seed catalogues, but not differing much in habit, at least in our climate.


